Youth Art Month 2008 – School Flags Across the U.S. are “Flying High.”

Each year, the Council for Art Education, Inc. (CAE) sponsors Youth Art Month. As a part of the 2008 effort, the CAE is again encouraging every state to enter a “state flag.” Art Educators of Minnesota (AEM), with more than 500 members, will select one original work, created by a K-12 student, to represent Minnesota.

The selected entry will be professionally made into a full-sized flag which will be flown in front of the U.S. Postal Service Building in Washington, D.C. during the month of March, 2008. This flag will also be displayed at the National Art Education Association (NAEA) conference, which will be held in New Orleans. The student whose work is selected, and their teacher, will be formally recognized at the AEM Capital Art Show reception on February 24, 2008.
