

Art & Design Term Faculty Positions

The University of Minnesota Duluth is seeking applications from qualified individuals for anticipated part time and/or full time term appointments for the 2011-12 academic year teaching Art Education, 2-D Design and Introduction to Art. The Art Education position will include some student teacher observation site visits.

Appointment will be at the rank of assistant professor with an MFA, at instructor with an MA. Salary will be based on experience and qualifications. Position start date is August 29th, 2011.

Essential qualifications:

-MA degree in Art, Design, or a related field prior to starting employment at the University of Minnesota Duluth. Related fields can include: Visual Arts, Graphic Design, Graphic Arts, Electronic Arts, Art Education, Studio Arts, and New Media.

-For the Art Education position; minimum 3 years art teaching experience in a public school setting.

-An exhibition record/public viewing of work.

-Familiarity with appropriate technologies and the historical/theoretical and critical aspects of the specific discipline(s) and art/design issues.

Preferred qualifications :

-MFA degree in Art, Design or related field (see above) prior to starting employment at the University of Minnesota Duluth.

-One year of experience teaching one of the above subjects at the college level. (Graduate TA experience is acceptable).
